## **APA 7 Style Citations**

Citation Formatting Basics:

- All references cited in the text should be listed alphabetically by author's last name.
- Pay close attention to the punctuation and layout citations are picky!
- Capitalize only the first word of a title and subtitle, the first word after a colon, and proper nouns.
- The DOI is the digital object identifier and can typically be found in the database record or at the top of the journal article.
